The Basics, your compass:

This course is designed to introduce the beginner, or novice to Land Navigation as it is a perishing skill. This course will re-acquaint the student to the two most important tools you take into the wilderness, your brain and compass. This course will systematically take the student through the care and use of both the direct and indirect reading compasses. True and Magnetic North's will be discussed along with measuring distance on foot.

Upon successful completion of this portion of the course, the student will have an operational knowledge and confidence in the use of both types of compasses, along with a high degree of confidence in ones self. Students will have the tools needed to progress to the intermediate and advanced levels. Prerequisite– open mind and proper attire for the weather.

Class size– 6 student minimum/24 max.

Equipment required– Silva/Suunto compass, pad and pencil, Military Lensatic compass optional.

INTERMEDIATE – MERGING MAP AND COMPASS:

This course is designed to bring the Basic/Rusty student to the next level of navigation. Thus bringing the use of compass and map together in a simple comprehensive manner

Upon completion of this level student will be able to orient the map, plot points, plot-routes, triangulate your position, and figure out where you are and where you want to go

The Student upon completion of the academic portion will be put through field exercises to build skill, understanding and confidence in one's skills and be confident to successfully navigate over 5 km of any terrain during the day.

Prerequisite: completion of basic course or compass competence (determined by course instructor)

Equipment required: 5 colored pencils; red, blue, green, brown, your choice, and a 12" ruler. Dress to be outside for the second half of the day.

Class Size– 6 student minimum/24 max.

Advanced Land Navigation: “Give It All You Got”

This Course is the culmination of the Land Navigation world. Once the student of this Level successfully graduates this course they will be able to handle whatever navigation Issue presents itself. Topics that will be covered and reinforced with field exercises. Night/Low visibility Navigation, Long range Navigation, GPS use in navigation, and Altimeter use as a navigation tool. A brief review of Basic/ Intermediate Navigation to ensure all are on the same map will be given, to ensure that all skills acquired up to this level will be sharp as it will take all of them to complete this level. This will be a challenging full day and will enhance your skills, knowledge, and confidence. Practice is the very best way not to lose this level of skill.

Prerequisites: Basic/Intermediate Land Navigation given by this school. Or prior competence determined by instructor.

Class Size– 6 student minimum/ 24 Max

Equipment required: same as intermediate, recommend bringing own GPS but not necessary.

Weekend package cost: \$150/person

(**Hint**: unless your map and compass skills are rock solid I do not recommend taking just GPS for Navigation.)
